Mr. Astorino presided.

Mr. Astorino said, "For the record, has the Secretary to the Board gone to the reception area to invite any members of the public who wish to attend today's meeting to come to the conference room?"

Mr. Astorino moved to receive and file the foregoing minutes and SEQR review, which were duly seconded and approved.

1. (50346) **Information Technology** - Enter into a grant agreement (IT-1378) with New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services (DHSES), in order to accept a grant awarded to the County by DHSES under New York State's 2015-16 Public Safety Answering Points Operations Grant Program in the amount of \$165,620 from 1/1/16 – 12/31/16 for eligible public safety call-taking and dispatching expenses.

Mr. Astorino moved the resolution, which was duly seconded and unanimously approved.

2. (50800) **County Attorney** – Enter into an outside counsel/retainer agreement with the law firm of Zwerling, Schacter & Zwerling, LLP, to represent the County in connection with the institution of legal proceedings against certain online sellers of hotel accommodations in order to recover Westchester County's Room Occupancy Tax, for a term commencing upon execution and terminating upon completion of services, under the listed terms and conditions.

3. (50152) **Planning** - Enter into any and all agreements necessary to purchase approximately 0.97+/-acre of real property located at 147, 165 and 175 Railroad Avenue, Bedford Hills in the Town of Bedford from Antioch Baptist Church Housing Development Fund Corp., its successor or assigns, for a total not to exceed amount of \$460,000 and to re-convey the property back to Antioch for one dollar (\$1.00) to create twelve (12) one and two bedroom units to affirmatively further fair housing, under the listed terms and conditions.

(50249) **CE/Emergency Services** - Amend the grant agreement with the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services wherein the County was awarded a grant in an amount not to exceed \$675,000 to enhance Westchester County's capability to prevent terrorist attacks and mitigate against man-made and natural hazards; protect the public, critical infrastructure and key resources, and prepare to respond to and recover from both man-made and natural disasters in compliance with the FY13 State Homeland Security Program, in order to extend the term of the agreement from 11/30/15 – 8/31/16.



Mr. Astorino moved the resolution, which was duly seconded and unanimously approved.


This meeting was recorded and an electronic copy of the minutes is on file with the Board of Acquisition and Contract.

Statement of Michael B. Kaplowitz,
Chairman of the Westchester County Board of Legislators

In 2011 the Westchester County Board of Legislators passed a local law that, among other things, made Board of Legislators' action sufficient to authorize the County Executive to implement Inter-Municipal Agreements – without approval of the Board of Acquisition and Contracts. The local law has subsequently been judicially sustained.

There is today a resolution before the Board of Acquisition and Contracts authorizing the County Executive to enter into Inter-Municipal Agreements.

I will vote for the resolution because I am in favor of the underlying matter. I recognize that the resolution is on the agenda pro forma.
