Mr. Astorino presided.

Mr. Astorino said, "For the record, has the Secretary to the Board gone to the reception area to invite any members of the public who wish to attend today's meeting to come to the conference room?"

Ms. Mrijaj confirmed that she had done so.

Mr. Astorino said, "I understand that the Budget Director wishes to make several motions."

Mr. Soule said, "I move to add item 18 (OnBase ID# 51612) to the agenda. This resolution would extend the term of a License Agreement with Clear Channel Outdoor, Inc. for the operation and maintenance of Westchester County Bus Shelters for the term April 1, 2011, through March 31, 2016 for three months from April 1, 2016 through June 30, 2016 at an annual License fee of \$875,000.00, in order to provide the necessary lead time for a new Licensee to begin providing services."

Mr. Kaplowitz seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Mr. Astorino said, "Your next motion please."

Mr. Soule said, "I move to add item 19 (OnBase ID# 51614) to the agenda. This resolution would amend an agreement with the Yonkers Chamber of Commerce for the provision of Employment Related Program Services for DSS Temporary Assistance Customers for the term April 1, 2013 through March 31, 2016 by extending the term of the contract for one month, to expire on April 30, 2016 at no additional cost to the County."

Mr. Astorino said, "Your next motion please."

Mr. Soule said, "I move to add item 20 (OnBase ID# 51629) to the agenda. This resolution would authorize the County to enter into a First Amendment to the Playland Management Agreement with Standard Amusements, LLC, in order extend the date that Standard Amusements has to terminate the Playland Management Agreement through and including April 29, 2016."

Mr. Kaplowitz seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Mr. Astorino said, "Your next motion please."

Mr. Soule continued, "I move to add items 21 and 22 (OnBase ID numbers 51635 and 51636) to the agenda. They are related items.

The first resolution would exempt from the Westchester County Procurement Policy the procurement of an agreement with the law firm of Holwell Shuster & Goldberg, LLP for the provision of consultant services to the County of Westchester in connection with the civil matter United States of America, ex rel. Anti-Discrimination Center of Metro New York, Inc. v. Westchester County, New York, and with other related matters as they arise, pursuant to Sec. 3(a)xxi of said Policy.

The second resolution would authorize the agreement with Holwell Shuster & Goldberg, LLP in an amount not to exceed \$100,000 at the rates set forth in Schedule A for a term commencing on March 31, 2016 and ending on March 30, 2017."

Mr. Astorino seconded the motion and it was approved by Mr. Soule and Mr. Astorino. Mr. Kaplowitz voted in the negative.

Mr. Astorino said, "Mr. Soule your next motion please."

Mr. Soule said, "I move to add item 23 (OnBase ID# 51637) to the agenda. This resolution would authorize the County to enter into a First Amendment to Agreement No. 15-954 with Woodard & Curran Engineering PA PC in the matter of Engineering Services in connection with Kensico Dam Plaza Reflecting Pool Restoration, Valhalla, New York."




This meeting was recorded and an electronic copy of the minutes is on file with the Board of Acquisition and Contract.
